Three stages of interventions Stage 3: Higher needs provision Stage 2: Targeted support Stage 1: **Universal Provision**

Stages of Provision	
Stage 1:	Quality first teaching is provided for all our pupils on a daily basis and will address the majority of pupils needs.
Stage 2:	This provision is targeted and is additional to what is provided for all children.
	This is normally in the form of small, group interventions to accelerate progress of learners.
	Children will be identified through data analysis for these interventions.
Stage 3:	This is targeted and personalised teaching for children who are identified as required additional support. This is where external specialists offer additional advice / support.
