Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to be able to share the outcome of our recent Ofsted inspection, which took place on 24th March 2026.

We are very pleased that the school was judged to be meeting the expected standard in all areas. Under the new Ofsted framework, this confirms that the school is securely delivering a good quality of education and care for all pupils. While it is difficult to make direct comparisons with the previous Ofsted framework, this judgement reflects that we are meeting the high national expectations now set for schools.

The report rightly recognises the dedication and hard work of both our pupils and staff. It highlights the positive culture across the school and the strength of relationships that underpin our community. Inspectors noted that,

'Pupils at Coleshill are happy within this caring school. Pupils feel they belong. Alongside understanding the importance of the Christian ethos of the school, pupils emphasise the love and belonging that school leaders promote.'

These comments reflect exactly what we strive to achieve every day; a nurturing environment where children feel valued, safe and ready to learn. The report also recognises that pupils behave well, enjoy their lessons and achieve well across the curriculum, particularly excelling in the times table check and with pupils achieving well in all subjects. Inspectors commented very positively on our inclusive approach, the robust support for pupils with additional needs, and the positive impact our pastoral support has on pupils' personal development and wellbeing.

As with any inspection, there are areas identified for further development, including continuing to strengthen handwriting, which inspectors noted we had already started work on. We are also continuing our strategic development of the wider curriculum, in particular the development of drawing skills. These are already priorities within our school improvement work, and we will continue to address them with determination as we move forward with our vision and development plans.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank our staff for their commitment, our governors and Trust for their support, and you, our families, for your continued partnership. Most importantly, I am incredibly proud of our pupils; this report is a testament to their attitude, behaviour and achievements.
